CO-OFFICIATION

2000

Members of the RRA may not co-officiate at a wedding or commitment ceremony with a non-Jewish clergy person. If a member violates this policy, he or she will be subject to any or all of the following possible sanctions, as determined by the Gevulot Committee and approved by the Executive Committee:

- warning
- suspension of referral privileges for life cycle events
- suspension of right to be an RRA officer or Board member
- suspension of voting privileges
- suspension of privilege of attending th RRA convention
- letter in placement file indicating that the member co-officiates in violation of RRA policy, of which congregations are advised when member applies
- suspension of placement privileges
