**PLACEMENT**

Whereas the RRA encourages its members to serve in positions of direct benefit to the movement and urges them to contribute their time to movement activities.

Be it resolved, that the RRA requires of new rabbinical college graduates that they accept as their first congregational placement a position in a FRCH member congregation provided that such placement does not impose a significant personal, familial or professional hardship as determined by a committee on Reconstructionist Service composed of the RRA's president, placement director, ethics committee chair; RRC's dean of students; and the FRCH's executive director.

Those not complying with this rule will be refused the service of RRA placement until they have satisfied this stipulation as interpreted by the Committee. In case of conflict, an appeal can be voted upon by the Executive Committee.
