RESOLUTION**

RESOLUTION POLICY

1985

Resolved, that all resolutions adopted at the June, 1985 Convention dealing with Reconstructionist belief be presented to the RRA for adoption by it in accordance with its procedures. In the event that the RRA does not adopt such resolutions, the resolutions shall be referred to a commission of FRCH and RRA with a view to the preparation of resolutions on lie subjects which represent a consensus of the two organizations. The "consensus resolutions" shall be acted upon at the first convention meeting of FRCH at which they are duly presented (hereinafter called the "second convention meeting"). Pending adoption of the resolutions on Reconstructionist belief adopted at the June, 1985 Conventions by the RRA or adoption of the consensus resolutions at the second convention meeting, neither set of resolutions shall be promulgated as representing a position of the Reconstructionist movement as a whole.

Further resolved, that the foregoing resolution shall be of no effect if in the opinion of the President and the Executive Director FRCH has adopted other procedures by which the resolutions on Reconstructionist belief adopted at the June, 1985 convention are to be reviewed by RRA prior to their being promulgated as representing a position of the Reconstructionist movement as a whole.
